


CIRCLE OVERLAND EXPEDITION

This is not just a holiday—it is a once-in-a-lifetime overland expedition across the top of Europe, designed for travellers who want to experience distance, landscape, culture, and achievement rather than just visit destinations.

Starting and ending in Stockholm, the journey unfolds across Sweden, Finland, Norway, and Denmark, covering nearly 6000 kilometres of some of the world's most scenic and well-engineered roads. From elegant Nordic capitals to remote Arctic highways, from frozen Lapland forests to dramatic Norwegian fjords, this expedition is a complete story of the North.

The early days immerse you in Scandinavian culture and design—Stockholm's Old Town, the Vasa Museum, world-famous subway art, and a serene Baltic Sea ferry crossing into Finland. As the journey progresses, cities gradually give way to vast wilderness, with Finland's lakelands leading into the silence and scale of Lapland. Crossing the Arctic Circle and driving to North Cape, the northernmost drivable point of Europe, is a defining milestone—raw, emotional, and unforgettable.

From the Arctic, the expedition turns south through Norway's most dramatic landscapes. Fjords carve deep into mountains, coastal highways cling to cliffs, and iconic routes like the Atlantic Ocean Road and the Lærdal Tunnel showcase the brilliance of Nordic engineering. Carefully placed rest days in cities like Trondheim, Bergen, Oslo, and Copenhagen balance long driving days with comfort, culture, and recovery.

This is a fully supported self-drive journey—you drive, but you are never alone. Routes, timing, safety, logistics, ferry crossings, and experiences are professionally planned so you can focus on the joy of the road. Driving days are paced thoughtfully, with scenic stops, viewpoint breaks, and immersive experiences rather than rushed checklists.

The expedition concludes in a celebratory rhythm—automotive heritage at the Volvo Museum, relaxed exploration of Copenhagen's design-led lifestyle, and a final return to Stockholm that completes the full Scandinavian loop. What begins as a route ends as a powerful personal story—of distance covered, landscapes conquered, and memories earned.

This journey is for those who believe that the world is not meant to be flown over, but driven through.



DAY 1 – STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN |

ARRIVAL + NORDIC WELCOME ●

Arrive in Stockholm and transfer to hotel (city centre preferred for walkability).

After airport pickup and transfer to your hotel, take time to rest and acclimatise after your international journey. In the evening, enjoy a gentle walk through the city centre, explore local cafés, or relax. Overnight: Stockholm



DAY 2 –



STOCKHOLM | GAMLA STAN + CULTURE DAY

Visit the iconic Vasa Museum, home to the world's only preserved 17th-century warship. Discover Sweden's maritime legacy and the dramatic story behind the Vasa's short but legendary voyage. Proceed to Gamla Stan (Old Town) for a guided walking tour. Explore cobbled streets, medieval lanes, royal squares, and colourful historic buildings. Free time for lunch at a café or souvenir shopping. Return to the hotel for rest or enjoy a quiet evening exploring nearby streets.

DAY 3 - STOCKHOLM | SUBWAY ART, CAR

PICKUP & NIGHT FERRY

Explore Stockholm's famous Stockholm Metro, often called the world's longest art gallery. Visit select underground stations showcasing murals, sculptures, and rock-cut installations. Proceed for vehicle pickup, officially marking the start of the self-drive expedition. Detailed briefing on Scandinavian road rules, safety norms, speed limits, fuel etiquette, and convoy protocols. Short familiarisation drive.



DAY 4 - TURKU → HELSINKI, FINLAND |

UNESCO ISLAND + CITY CENTRE

Arrive in Turku early morning and begin your drive toward Helsinki. En route, stop for breakfast and enjoy a scenic viewpoint showcasing Finland's forests and coastline. Reach Helsinki around 1:00 PM for hotel check-in. Later in the afternoon, take a ferry to Suomenlinna Sea Fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage Site spread across multiple islands. Spend 3-4 hours exploring historic fortifications, coastal walks, and museums. Evening and night are free to explore Helsinki's lively city centre.

DAY 5 - HELSINKI → JYVÄSKYLÄ |

FINLAND LAKELAND DRIVE ●

Begin the day with a guided Helsinki city tour, covering Senate Square, Helsinki Cathedral, Market Square, and modern Nordic architecture. After lunch, depart for Jyväskylä—the gateway to Finland’s Lakeland region. The drive offers peaceful scenery, endless pine forests, lakes, and open roads ideal for relaxed self-driving. Arrive by evening and check into your hotel. Overnight stay in Jyväskylä.



DAY 6 - JYVÄSKYLÄ → ROVANIEMI |

ENTER LAPLAND ●

After an early breakfast, begin one of the most scenic and meaningful drives of the expedition as you head north toward Rovaniemi. This 600 km journey takes you through Finland’s vast wilderness—dense pine forests, frozen lakes, and quiet Nordic highways. Regular breaks are planned for lunch and refreshments along the way. As you move further north, notice the changing landscape and Arctic atmosphere. Arrive in Rovaniemi by evening and check in to your hotel.

DAY 7 – ROVANIEMI | ARCTIC CIRCLE +

SANTA CLAUS VILLAGE ●

Today is dedicated to exploring the capital of Finnish Lapland. Begin with a relaxed riverside walk along the Kemijoki River, soaking in the calm Arctic surroundings. Enjoy lunch at an Indian restaurant for comfort and familiarity. In the afternoon, visit the world-famous Santa Claus Village, where you officially cross the Arctic Circle and receive your personalised Arctic Circle Crossing Certificate. Free time to explore souvenir shops and Arctic-themed attractions. Optional experiences such as reindeer rides, husky safaris, or photos with Santa are available (not included). Overnight stay in Rovaniemi.



DAY 8 – ROVANIEMI → INARI | DEEP

LAPLAND ●

After an early breakfast, begin one of the most scenic and meaningful drives of the expedition as you head north toward Rovaniemi. This 600 km journey takes you through Finland's vast wilderness—dense pine forests, frozen lakes, and quiet Nordic highways. Regular breaks are planned for lunch and refreshments along the way. As you move further north, notice the changing landscape and Arctic atmosphere. Arrive in Rovaniemi by evening and check in to your hotel.


DAY 9 - INARI → NORTH CAPE (VIA NORWAY) | THE EDGE OF EUROPE ●

Today marks a historic milestone of the expedition. After breakfast, drive toward North Cape, the northernmost point of mainland Europe accessible by road. The route takes you through dramatic Arctic terrain, fjords, and coastal roads. Stand at the iconic North Cape globe monument overlooking the Arctic Ocean—a once-in-a-lifetime experience. After spending time at the plateau, continue to Honningsvåg for overnight stay. Evening at leisure to relax and reflect on reaching the top of Europe.



DAY 10 - NORTH CAPE → TROMSØ | ARCTIC FJORDS DRIVE ●

After breakfast, begin the scenic drive to Tromsø (approx. 6 hours). The route features fjords, mountain passes, and dramatic Arctic scenery. Arrive by afternoon and check in to your hotel. Spend the evening exploring Tromsø city centre, often referred to as the “Paris of the North.” Cafés, waterfront views, and Arctic culture make this a lively yet relaxed Arctic city. Overnight stay in Tromsø.



DAY 11 – TROMSØ | CABLE CAR + NORTHERN

LIGHTS HUNTING ●

Start the day with a cable car ride to the top of Tromsø's viewpoint, offering panoramic views of fjords, islands, and snow-covered peaks. Afternoon is reserved for rest and preparation. After an early dinner, embark on a Northern Lights hunting tour by bus, guided by local experts who track aurora activity for the best viewing chances. Late-night return to the hotel after this unforgettable Arctic experience.



DAY 12 – TROMSØ → FAUSKE | NORWAY'S

REMOTE HIGHWAYS ●

After breakfast, depart Tromsø and begin a full-day scenic drive toward Fauske. This stretch of the journey takes you through some of Northern Norway's most dramatic landscapes—fjords cutting deep into mountains, snow-covered peaks, remote fishing villages, and long Arctic highways. Regular comfort and photography stops are planned along the way. The drive is immersive and rewarding, showcasing Norway's raw natural beauty. Arrive in Fauske by evening and check in to your hotel. Overnight stay in Fauske.

DAY 13 - FAUSKE → TRONDHEIM | ARCTIC

CIRCLE CENTRE STOP ●

Today's drive leads you south toward Trondheim, marking the transition from Arctic Norway into central Scandinavia. En route, stop at the Arctic Circle Centre (Norway)—a symbolic and memorable moment of crossing out of the Arctic region. Continue through changing landscapes as mountains soften into valleys and rivers. Reach Trondheim by evening and check in to your hotel. The night is free to relax after a long drive.



DAY 14 - TRONDHEIM | REST DAY + CITY

EXPLORATION ●

This day is reserved for rest and independent exploration. Trondheim is one of Norway's most historic cities, known for its Viking past and colourful waterfront warehouses. Explore the city centre, stroll along the riverfront, visit local cafés, or simply enjoy a slow day after several intense driving days. Overnight stay in Trondheim.

DAY 15 - TRONDHEIM → ÅLESUND |

ATLANTIC OCEAN ROAD

Depart Trondheim and head toward Ålesund via one of the most iconic driving routes in the world—the Atlantic Ocean Road. This engineering marvel connects small islands via dramatic bridges over the open sea. Stop at famous viewpoints including the Storseisundet Bridge, often listed among the world's most scenic roads. Continue onward through coastal Norway and arrive in Ålesund by evening. Check in and enjoy the coastal atmosphere. Overnight stay in Ålesund.



DAY 16 - ÅLESUND → GEIRANGER →


ØYRAPLASSEN | SKYWALK + FJORD STAY

After breakfast, drive toward Geiranger, one of Norway's most spectacular fjord regions. The route includes mountain roads, waterfalls, and dramatic viewpoints. Visit the famous Geiranger Skywalk, offering breathtaking panoramic views over the fjord below. After sightseeing, continue your drive to Lindstrøm Hotel, Øyrapplassen, located in a peaceful fjord setting. Overnight stay surrounded by nature.

DAY 17 - ØYRAPLASSEN → FLÅM →

BERGEN | FJORDS & VALLEYS

Begin the day with a drive to Flåm, passing through narrow valleys and scenic mountain roads. Flåm sits at the heart of Norway's fjord country and is famous for its dramatic surroundings. Continue onward to Bergen, Norway's historic coastal capital. The drive offers continuous visual highlights—waterfalls, tunnels, and fjord crossings. Arrive in Bergen by evening and check in to your hotel.



DAY 18 BERGEN | PRIVATE WALKING TOUR

+ MOUNT ULRIKEN

Explore Bergen with a private guided walking tour, covering Bryggen Wharf (UNESCO site), historic streets, and harbourfront landmarks. Later, take the cable car to Mount Ulriken, Bergen's highest viewpoint, for sweeping views of the city and surrounding fjords. Evening at leisure to explore Bergen's lively food and cultural scene. Overnight stay in Bergen.

DAY 19 – BERGEN | FJORD CRUISE

This morning, embark on a fjord cruise (approx. 4 hours, starting at 10:00 AM), sailing through narrow fjords, steep cliffs, and cascading waterfalls. This experience offers a different perspective of Norway's landscapes—from the water. Return to Bergen in the afternoon. The rest of the day is free for shopping, cafés, or relaxation. Overnight stay in Bergen.



DAY 20 – BERGEN → OSLO | E16 +

LÆRDAL TUNNEL

Depart Bergen and drive toward Oslo via the scenic E16 Highway. En route, pass through the Lærdal Tunnel, the world's longest road tunnel at 25 km. The journey combines mountain passes, tunnels, valleys, and lakes. Arrive in Oslo after approximately 8 hours of driving. Check in and relax. Overnight stay in Oslo.

DAY 21 – OSLO | CITY WALK + FREE TIME



Enjoy a half-day guided walking tour of Oslo, covering key highlights such as the city centre, waterfront areas, and cultural landmarks. The afternoon is free for museums, shopping, or café hopping. Oslo offers a blend of modern architecture and natural beauty. Overnight stay in Oslo.



DAY 22 – OSLO → GOTHENBURG (VOLVO MUSEUM) → COPENHAGEN



Depart Bergen and drive toward Oslo via the scenic E16 Highway. En route, pass through the Lærdal Tunnel, the world's longest road tunnel at 25 km. The journey combines mountain passes, tunnels, valleys, and lakes. Arrive in Oslo after approximately 8 hours of driving. Check in and relax. Overnight stay in Oslo.

DAY 23 - COPENHAGEN | CITY TOUR + EXPERIENCES DAY ●

A full free day to explore Copenhagen at your own pace. Visit landmarks such as Nyhavn, Tivoli Gardens, Amalienborg Palace, or enjoy canal walks and shopping streets. Copenhagen is known for its relaxed vibe, design culture, and excellent cuisine. Overnight stay in Copenhagen.



DAY 24 - COPENHAGEN → STOCKHOLM | FINAL DRIVE + TRIP END ●

After breakfast, drive back to Gothenburg. Upon arrival, return the vehicle and conclude your unforgettable 25-day overland expedition across Scandinavia and the Arctic Circle. Depart with lifelong memories of fjords, Arctic highways, and Nordic cultures.
