ROAD TO LONDON



Week 1 – India & Nepal



Our epic journey begins in Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh, where travelers gather to meet the team and fellow adventurers. From here, we cross into Nepal at Lumbini, the birthplace of Lord Buddha, with its serene monasteries and meditation centers.

We continue to Bharatpur, a warm gateway city, before reaching Kathmandu, Nepal's lively capital. In Kathmandu, we explore Durbar Square, with its intricately carved palaces and temples. We visit Swayambhunath Stupa (Monkey Temple), offering sweeping views of the valley. The sacred Pashupatinath Temple and grand Boudhanath Stupa deepen the city's spiritual aura. This first week balances discovery and relaxation, while completing visa formalities for the road ahead.

Week 2 – Tibet, China

The adventure deepens as we cross into Tibet at Rasuwagadhi, greeted by crisp air in Gyirong and Tingri amid towering Himalayan peaks. A highlight of the week is Everest Base Camp, at the foot of Mount Qomolangma, the world's highest mountain—an awe-inspiring moment of a lifetime. We continue to Shigatse, Tibet's second-largest city, where we complete formalities and visit the ancient Tashilhunpo Monastery, seat of the Panchen Lama. From there, the road ascends to Lhasa, Tibet's mystical capital.

Here, we marvel at the majestic Potala Palace, rising 380 feet above Red Hill, a symbol of Tibetan resilience and faith. At the sacred Jokhang Temple, we join pilgrims on Barkhor Street, filled with prayer wheels, incense, and colorful Tibetan crafts. This week blends the grandeur of the Himalayas with the depth of Tibetan spirituality.

Week 3 – Across the Roof of the World



Week three takes us through Tibet's rugged mountains to Damxung, with a pause at the stunning Namtso Lake, the "Heavenly Lake," perched over 15,400 feet high. We cross the vast Qiangtang Grasslands, spotting nomads, yaks, and antelopes, before driving through Amdo and dramatic high passes. The road leads us to Golmud, a Silk Road stop where desert meets snow peaks.

By midweek, we reach Dunhuang, an oasis in the Gobi Desert, famed for Crescent Lake and the singing Mingsha Sand Dunes. Evenings here come alive with desert skies, local music, and performances. We end the week at the legendary Mogao Caves, a UNESCO site with 500 grottoes adorned with Buddhist art over a millennium old.


Week 4 – China & Kyrgyzstan



From Turpan, we drive westward to Kuerle, Xinjiang's second-largest city, famous for its vibrant night markets and fragrant pears. After a restful stay, the road leads us to Aksu, on the edge of the vast Tarim Basin. Here we explore the enchanting Populus Forest Park, where golden poplar trees light up the desert in autumn. The adventure intensifies on the Tarim Desert Expressway, one of the world's longest desert highways.

We cut across the legendary Taklamakan Desert—a true test of driving skill and endurance. Our reward is Kashgar, the “Pearl of the Silk Road,” with over 2,000 years of history. Kashgar's Old Town mesmerizes with narrow alleys, mudbrick houses, and ornate gates. From here, we ascend the dramatic Pamir Highway, flanked by the mighty “Roof of the World. Crossing into Kyrgyzstan, we reach Osh, then end the week in Uzbekistan's fertile Fergana Valley.

Week 5 – Uzbekistan & Kazakhstan



The week begins in Uzbekistan, Central Asia's crown jewel. From Fergana, we travel to Tashkent, exploring the bustling Chorsu Bazaar, the Museum of Applied Arts, and the gleaming Minor Mosque.

Crossing into Kazakhstan, our first stop is Turkistan, home to the Mausoleum of Khoja Ahmed Yasawi, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. From there, we drive to Aralsk, once a port on the Aral Sea, now a haunting reminder of ecological change.

Continuing onward, we reach Aktobe, a lively city rich in culture, and end the week in Atyrau, the transcontinental city on the banks of the Ural River, where Europe meets Asia.

Week 6 – Kazakhstan & Russia



Crossing into Russia, we arrive in Astrakhan, the “Caspian capital,” on the banks of the Volga River. A boat ride on the Volga is a perfect way to unwind here.

From Astrakhan, we continue across sweeping plains to Elista, the only Buddhist city in European Russia, home to the Golden Abode of Buddha Shakyamuni Monastery.

Further west, the spectacular Mount Elbrus, Europe’s highest peak at 18,510 feet, awaits us. A cable car ride offers breathtaking views of the Caucasus.

We end the week in Verkhniy Fiagdon, a peaceful village in North Ossetia-Alania, famous for its meadows, rivers, and mineral springs—an ideal place to rest and rejuvenate.

Week 7 -- Georgia & Turkey



Crossing into Georgia, we reach Tbilisi, a colorful capital of cobblestone lanes, pastel houses, and lively cafes. Highlights include the Old Town, the sulfur baths, and the glowing Bridge of Peace. Nearby Mtskheta offers the UNESCO-listed Svetitskhoveli Cathedral and Jvari Monastery.

Crossing into Turkey, we visit Erzurum before reaching the magical region of Cappadocia. Here, surreal fairy chimneys, cave churches, and an optional hot air balloon ride create unforgettable memories. We close the week in Kayseri, a hub of history and trade.

Week 8 – Türkiye, Bulgaria & Serbia



We arrive in Istanbul, the city where East meets West. From the Hagia Sophia and Blue Mosque to the Grand Bazaar, the city is alive with history. A Bosphorus cruise crowns our Turkish journey. Crossing into Bulgaria, we spend time in Sofia, exploring the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral and relaxed boulevards.

Finally, we reach Belgrade, Serbia's lively capital, with its Kalemegdan Fortress and bustling nightlife.

Week 9 – Eastern to Western Europe



In Prague, Czechia's fairytale capital, we explore the Charles Bridge, Astronomical Clock, and medieval squares. Driving into Germany, we pass through scenic countryside to Frankfurt and the Rhine Valley, famous for castles and vineyards. Our week ends in the Netherlands, exploring Amsterdam's canals, world-class museums, and vibrant neighborhoods.

From Belgrade, we cross through Croatia before reaching Budapest, Hungary's stunning capital. Highlights include the Parliament Building, Buda Castle, Fisherman's Bastion, and a Danube River cruise by night. We then visit Bratislava, Slovakia, with its castle overlooking a charming Old Town.

Week 10 – France & United Kingdom



We pause in Brussels, Belgium, to explore the UNESCO-listed Grand Place and sample world-famous chocolates and waffles. From there, we cross into France, reaching Calais for our ferry ride. Excitement peaks as the White Cliffs of Dover appear on the horizon. Finally, we drive into London, with the Indian flag flying proudly on our vehicles a deeply emotional moment marking the successful completion of our road to London.

The adventure concludes with a farewell dinner, celebrating the friendships and memories forged along this once-in-a-lifetime journey. This is the Road to London—an odyssey that will live forever in memory.
