# ITINERARY

## WEEK 1 | THE BEGINNING OF THE ROAD

India → Nepal

The expedition begins in Gorakhpur with a warm meet-and-greet, vehicle checks, and detailed briefings. By morning, the convoy rolls out — not in a rush, but with intent.

Crossing into Nepal, the landscape begins to change. Flat plains give way to rolling hills and distant mountains. The road leads us to Kathmandu, where we slow down and prepare for the most dramatic part of the journey ahead.

# WEEK 2 | THE HIMALAYAN ASCENT

## Nepal → Tibet

Leaving Kathmandu, the road climbs steadily into the mountains. The air grows thinner, the scenery grander, and the silence more powerful. Crossing into Tibet feels like entering another world. Vast plateaus stretch endlessly, prayer flags dance in the wind, and the scale of nature is overwhelming. This week brings one of the most unforgettable moments of the expedition — standing face to face with Mount Everest. Visiting Everest Base Camp and Rongbuk Monastery is both humbling and surreal. The journey continues toward Lhasa, the spiritual heart of Tibet, where ancient monasteries and sacred streets offer a deeper connection to the land.

# WEEK 3 | FROM ROOF OF THE WORLD TO HIDDEN PARADISES

**Tibet → China (Yunnan)**

After a well-deserved pause in Lhasa, the expedition gradually descends from the high plateau into greener landscapes. Snow-covered mountains transform into forests, rivers, and valleys. The road flows through eastern Tibet into China's Yunnan province — a region known for its diversity, beauty, and old-world charm.

# WEEK 4 | THE HEART OF SOUTHEAST ASIA

China → Laos → Thailand

Leaving China, we enter Laos — where time seems to slow down. Roads wind through mountains, rivers, and quiet villages, offering a peaceful transition into Southeast Asia. Luang Prabang introduces us to a softer rhythm — temples, riverside evenings, and cultural depth. Crossing into Thailand, the energy changes once again. Tropical air, modern highways, and bustling towns welcome us. By the time we reach Bangkok, the convoy has transformed into a close-knit community.
